McNALLY, EDWARD M. Edward M. McNally, MD, passed away in his home in La Jolla, California on December 12, 2006, surrounded by his loving family and friends. Ed graduated from the Bronx High School of Science in 1950 and Queens College with a degree in Music in 1954. He graduated with a degree in medicine from New York University in 1960. He completed his internship and residency in Internal Medicine at St. Vincent's Hospital in New York City, followed by a fellowship in cardiology at the Michael Reese Hospital and Medical Center in Chicago. Dr. McNally moved to La Jolla in 1965 to continue his fellowship in Cardiology at Scripps Clinic and Research Foundation.
